Install a smart thermostat

- Save up to 20% on cooling costs and 5% on heating costs by installing an ENERGY STAR®, WiFi-enabled smart thermostat.²
- Smart thermostats automatically adjust temperature settings and offer features like occupancy sensing, remote scheduling and intelligent control of HVAC equipment.

Add Demand Controlled Ventilation (DCV)

- Save up to 40% on heating and cooling costs by adding CO₂ sensors to spaces like sanctuaries, classrooms and auditoriums.
- DCV controls your HVAC system based on occupancy to eliminate unnecessary heating and cooling while still keeping occupant comfort a top priority.

Check doors and windows for air leaks

- Your building requires more energy for heating and cooling when leaks exist.
- Examine your building and repair air leaks with weather stripping and caulking to prevent the loss of conditioned air.

Maintain your steam system

- Each foot of uninsulated steam pipe wastes an average of \$7.50 per year in energy costs – yet only costs about \$8 to fix.
- Surveying and repairing steam traps can save over
 \$100 per year for each trap failed open.²
