






How to effectively use your fan

Furnaces with an electronically commutated motor, or ECM, automatically adjust to changes in air pressure to heat spaces more efficiently and ensure optimal air flow.

Run the fan on "auto" for the biggest energy and cost savings. FOCUS ON ENERGY® recommends you only switch your fan to "on" if you are addressing indoor air quality issues or removing dust from the air during house cleaning. Once you're done, turn it back to auto. Your pocket book will thank you.



Importance of upkeep
